

The new Civil Procedure Act is in front of the Parliament

The Parliament debate on the draft version of the new Civil Procedure Act, the detailed debate commenced on October 3, 2016.

Declared objectives of the new law are to put in place a more efficient litigation system and new rules motivating mediation, to introduce a split litigation structure and new rules for group litigations, to impose mandatory attorney representation at regional courts to ensure professional conduct, and to enhance electronic court proceedings.

If accepted, the new law will apply to court procedures commenced on or after January 1, 2018.
